	Stop contributing to your HSA, if you have one.	
Three months before turning 65	Enroll yourself in Medicare Part A & B.	
	Make an appointment to finalize your plan choice and enrollment if you desire coverage options beyond Original Medicare.	
Happy 65 th Birthday!	If you're not enrolled yet, call a licensed insurance agent ASAP for help.	
Three months after turning 65	Your Medicare initial enrollment period ends. You must wait for the next enrollment window if you don't start Medicare this month.
